

Sports Premium 2016/17

This year, PE continues to benefit from Sport Premium funding. This year we will receive £9260 in two payments. Our target is to improve the quality of PE teaching and extend the provision of sports opportunities.

This year, we aim to improve the quality of teaching in dance lessons. We have purchased a new scheme of work called Imoves Dance at a cost of £945 (over three years). This scheme includes a variety of topic based plans for teachers and is taught through the interactive whiteboard. Training for staff will take place during the Spring term (£180). This term, four members of staff have worked alongside a dance coach to deliver lessons around a topical theme (£500). Working alongside a professional coach, staff have developed their skills and the children have enjoyed being taught by a dance professional.

We continue to encourage children to be active during their lunch break. RuggerEds work with our KS2 children for two lunchtime sessions per week in KS2 (£2100) and Links coaches work with our KS1 children twice a week (£1600).

We continue to monitor and target children who do not take part in extra-curricular sport. Last term, we developed a whole school database for this purpose.

At the end of the Summer term, the Sport Premium funding was used to map out our school grounds for orienteering (£150). When the maps are ready and the markers have been put in position, staff will receive training in 2017 and then the school grounds can be utilised to develop map reading skills, language and communication skills.

We continue to build links with local clubs such as Sheffield Hockey Club, Hallamshire Tennis and Squash Club.

Last year, we received the Silver School Games Award in recognition for the wide range of after school sport opportunities we provide, our involvement in competitive sport, club links and leadership opportunities for children.

We aim to provide a wide variety of after school sports clubs which change each term. We currently offer:-

yoga, football (KS1 and KS2), netball, rugby, hockey, cheerleading, gymnastics, Razzamataz .

Through our subscription to Links Sports Partnership (£2384), we are able to access staff training, access specialist coaches and a range of inter – school sports competitions such as Sports Hall Athletics, Hotshots basketball, football, netball, tennis, rounders, cricket, bouldering, swimming.
