On Tuesday we had a Fair trade Assembly by Lucy Morley, who runs the Fair Trade shop 'Good Taste' in Broomhill. Lucy explained to the children the principles of Fair Trade and how it is set up to allow farmers and producers to receive a fair price for their products. Lucy explained how the cost of a banana is calculated and how little of this can actually go to the farmer.

The children also found out about the journey of a chocolate bar and how little the farmers can get for their beans. The children were very interested and had lots of questions. Lucy set the children a challenge. Firstly, spot the Fair Trade symbol when you next go to the shops. Secondly, see if you can swap a fair trade product for one of your regular purchases. (Of course with your parents permission). The children were able to link the Fair Trade Mission with our own Mission Statement, Everybody Matters.
