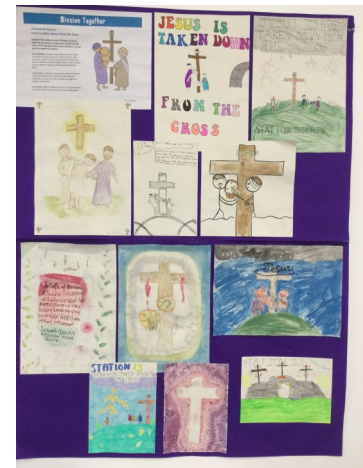
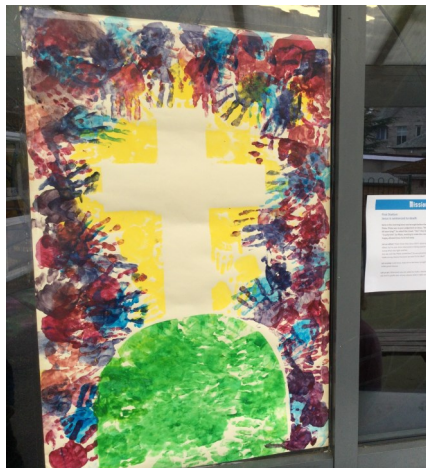
We are also receiving a large amount of lost property. To help prevent this, please make sure that all items—including sandboxes, clothing, and water bottles—are clearly named.

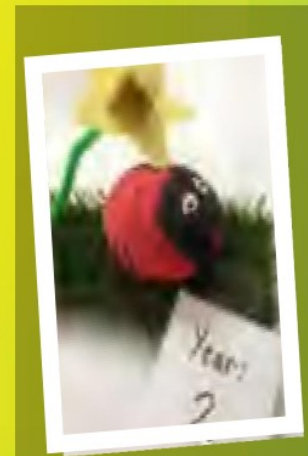

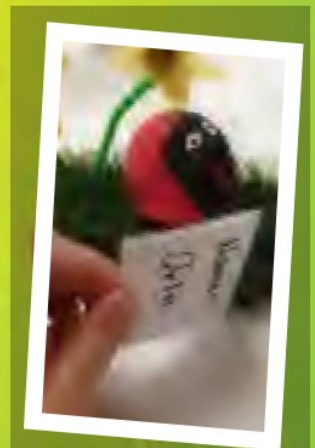
