Their project focused on football skills, and also inclusivity, who really impressed the organisers. Well done girls!



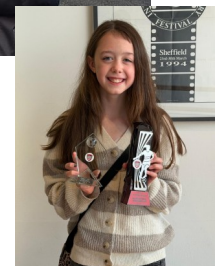
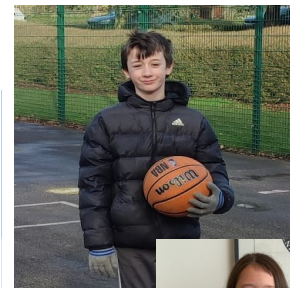
